Summary SB 811 PN 995

This legislation requires the Department of Aging to create a publicly accessible website for long-term living facilities which includes licensure and certification information. Nursing facilities, personal care homes and domiciliary care homes would be included.

The website shall be updated on a monthly basis and shall include contact information for the facility, the status of the current license or certification including the date it was issued and the expiration date, as well as information regarding inspections and violations. The Department's website shall also include any enforcement actions taken or penalties assessed against the facility within the preceding 24 months and any corrective actions taken.

Currently, consumers or their families are only able to access information regarding nursing facilities. Both the Departments of Welfare and Aging collect the information required by the bill for the facilities they license, but it is not posted on a publicly accessible website.

Effective Date

The act shall take effect in 60 days.
